Most ophthalmologists are well informed regarding optic neuritis, it's recent advances and treatment. When an MRI shows T 2 hyperintensity of the optic nerve, it is usually considered to be due to optic neuritis and treated for the same. A recent study published in the Journal of Neuro Ophthalmology showed however that only 141 of 583 (24%) of eyes with optic nerve hyperintensity were caused by inflammation that is optic neuritis. When it comes to non inflammatory optic neuropathies, general ophthalmologist are less sure regarding the diagnosis, evaluation and treatment. We aim to address the same by presenting on drug (ATT and cancer chemotherapy) related, radiation induced, compressive, and inherited optic neuropathies along with recent advances in the management of traumatic and ischemic optic neuropathies.

Performing cataract surgery in patients with extremely dense rock-hard cataracts is very challenging. These highly dense opaque cataracts make perioperative visualization of the capsule difficult. These lenses are hard to maneuver and typically occupy a larger volume. The lens capsule is thin and fragile, zonules are weak. This type of cataract requires longer phaco times and higher energy levels. Some of them are associated with small pupils and other situations like zonular dialysis. To get favourable outcomes in these patients often a combination of technique and technology is required.

[IC48] - RHEGMATOGENOUS RD SIMPLIFIED: MANAGEMENT OF SIMPLE TO COMPLEX CASES

**CATEGORY: VITREO RETINAL DISEASES**

Rhegmatogenous retinal detachment (RRD) was once considered a blinding disorder. Jules Gonin in 1929 first proposed that retinal break is the cause of RRD, and advocated the treatment modality of 'ignipuncture-coagulations'. Treatment options for RRD have constantly evolved since then. Current treatment options for RRD include pars plana vitrectomy with tamponade (gas or silicone oil), scleral buckle with/without SRF drainage, combined PPV with encircling band, etc. The steps of PPV and scleral buckling are often complex and difficult to understand. This IC is being proposed to be conducted by experienced VR surgeons with an aim to give an overview of the evaluation of RRD and simplify and demystify the various complex steps involved in PPV and scleral buckling. This IC will also provide an overview on the management of complex RRDs like GRT-RD, RD with macular hole, RD with PVR, re-detachment cases etc.

#### [Ic31] - HOW TO HANDLE UVEITIS PATIENTS: A STEP-WISE APPROACH OF DIAGNOSIS AND MANAGEMENT

Uveitis is relatively uncommon and a complex disease comprising of 80 possible etiologies. These diseases often have protean manifestations with varying grades of severity. It often poses a challenge to the general ophthalmologist regarding the diagnosis, selection of investigations and management. ### [IC46] - SECONDARY INTRACOCULAR LENS IMPLANTATION IN PAEDIATRIC APHAKIA- CURRENT PARADIGMS

**CATEGORY: PAEDIATRIC OPHTHALMOLOGY**

This course highlights the paradigms for secondary IOL implantation in challenging paediatric aphakia. Adhering to these will help the surgeon to enhance a good technical and functional outcome. While dramatic advances have occurred in this field over the past decade, some aspects of surgery, such as changing refraction and functional outcomes, continue to pose significant problems. This course intends to help a paediatric cataract surgeon decide which secondary IOL to choose in different case scenarios. With the availability of myriad IOL power methods, an experience-based talk is planned for appropriate IOL power calculation considering a myopic shift. We plan to venture into clinical case-based and video-based teaching of various positions of placement of secondary IOLs. Sulcus placement in paediatric aphakia and in traumatic cases. Orbit is a pandora's box. However, it can be very well decoded by simple imaging techniques like B-scan. CT scan and MRI. Orbital B-scan is a simple tool which every ophthalmologist can use to diagnose orbital diseases. B-scan is also useful for ultrasound guided biopsies and administration of intra-orbital injections. This IC will highlight the role of different types of imaging techniques and sequences (CT, MRI, contrast imaging, Diffusion weighted imaging, Digital subtraction angiography) which help in establishing a diagnosis in orbital diseases and also aid in assessing management.


